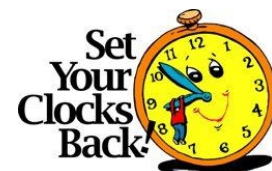
Our family can't wait to be there with you and I know that feeling is mutual. Know already that you are loved and prayed for.

In November, we will be looking to the New Testament to learn about prayer, friendship, gratitude and helping others.

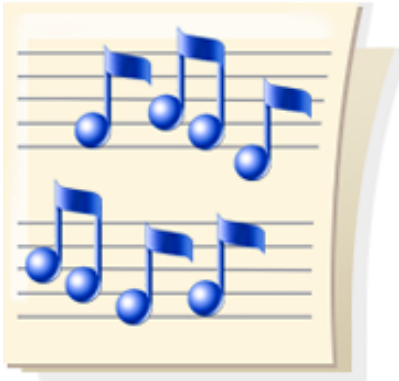
Our memory verse is Proverbs 3:5.
